POA State Requirements

This article assists in understanding each state requirement for Power of Attorney completion.

Details

The **Power of Attorney (POA)** document is an important step in your unemployment claims service. It allows our team to provide your organization with full services. The grid below provides state specific requirements to help when completing POAs.

Signature Type: Each state has requirements on how you can sign the POA. Electronic means you can sign electronically via Adobe Sign and Original means you will have to physically sign the POA and submit it to **Employers Edge** for processing.

Online: The state requires you to act by registering **Employers Edge** as Third Party Administrator (TPA) on the state's UI website.

Applied For: The state will accept POAs for state accounts in an Applied For status.

Notary Seal: The state requires the signature and stamp of a notary.

Corporate Seal: If you have a corporate seal, it should be done in this field. If you do not have one, you can write 'no seal*.

Officer's List: The state asks us to provide a list of entity officers on your company letterhead with the POA.

Witness: The state requires a second signature to confirm that the POA signer is who they claim to be.
