Digital channels have a significant stake in today's economy, increasing the need for improved identity verification. With growing digital emphasis, companies face the challenge of building and maintaining a seamless identity verification experience for these online transactions.

Document Verification is a multi-level approach to starting consumer relationships off right by verifying your customers have known identities and are more likely who they say they are, helping you to incrementally **increase confidence** in identity validity.

Why Document Verification?

Document Verification when used for account origination, either in-store or for digital transactions, helps customers to:

- Quickly identify identity documents that are not consistent with issuer formats
- Automate and streamline workflows to increase operational efficiency
- Reduce manual identity verification processes
- Help minimize the inherent risk of conducting personal and sensitive transactions in digital environments

Features

Verifies the information on the front and back of a government-issued identity document and authenticates a consumer by matching the consumer's face (via selfie photo) with the photo on front of the document

Answers: Is this a known identity — is this person more likely to be the person they say they are?

Consumers don't have to physically show proof of identity as all interaction is via their mobile phone

Verifies identity through mobile capture and facial recognition

Features include:

- Document scan/validation (driver's licenses, state-issued ID cards, temporary IDs — 49 states [*not approved for use with Illinois residents], and five US territories); additional document support is seamless (future releases)
- Face scan/match
- · Liveness detection

Verification results are returned real-time

How does it work?

Three easy steps





Customer makes simple API call with consumer phone number, which initiates an SMS to consumer's mobile device



Consumer walks through a two/threestep capture flow (for document validation and/or facial match with liveness detection)



Customer makes API call to determine consumer's results, including:

- Score: Yes or No +
- Reason codes +
- Details Document Verification
