Greetings! The Crime Victim Assistance Division of the Iowa Attorney General is pleased to announce a new version of Iowa Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE). Thank you for your interest in joining the Iowa VINE Service Provider Directory.

All agencies/organizations must read and review the following criteria and guidelines before submitting their information for review:

- Agencies/organizations must provide services in Iowa, regardless of the location of agency headquarters. Services include emergency support, basic needs, counseling, healthcare, legal/financial aid, and children's services.
- Agencies/organizations are required to update and maintain their information annually or as changes occur. Failure to do so may be grounds for removal.

The following will exclude agencies/organizations from participation:

- Discrimination against individuals based on race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity, pregnancy, childbirth or pregnancy-related conditions, genetic information and membership in the armed forces or reserves.
- Misrepresentation of agency/organization or its services in any way, including nondelivery of services or participation in illegal or fraudulent activities.

The VINE Program Manager will screen all submissions. Submission of the Service Provider Form does not guarantee inclusion in the directory.

We look forward to working with you to ensure victims of crime have accurate, up to date information about the resources available to them.
